> Elisabeth Louise Vigée Le Brun was a French artist, born in Paris in 1755 who achieved early success as an artist. Her ability to depict her subjects in a flattering, elegant style made her one of the most popular portraitists in France. Her clientele included aristocracy and royalty, including Marie Antoinette, whose portrait she painted 30 times. After the French Revolution, the artist travelled with her daughter for over 12 years painting clients throughout Europe. She returned to Paris for her later life and continued to enjoy a degree of fame and success that was very rare for a female artist.
